### Overview

The Guide to PHARMACOLOGY (GtoImmuPdb) is an extension to the Guide to PHARMACOLOGY (GtoPdb).

This second, alpha-release (version 2.0), follows 1 month on from the first, alpha-release (version 1.0).

These release notes detail only new and modified features from v1.0 to v2.0. Please refer to the release notes for v1.0 for comprehensive details.

### Included in this release

#### 1. GtoImmuPdb Portal

##### i. Menu Bars

- New menu item for **Processes**
  - sub-items (7) are each of the main process categories. These link directly to the Immuno Process Association List Pages, focussed on the selected category.
- New menu item for **Cell Types**
  - sub-items (7) are each of the main cell type categories. These link directly to the Immuno Cell Type Association List Pages, focussed on the selected category.
- **About** menu reduced, to only have link to about GtoImmuPdb, a sub-menu gives original about list from GtoPdb
- **Ligand** menu item links to **updated ligand list pages** (see item later), with focus on Immuno tab
- **Resources** menu item has been modified to link to GtoImmuPdb help and tutorials. GtoPdb help items are put into sub-menu list. News remains linking to existing, GtoPdb, news pages.

##### ii. Ligands

- List of ligand groupings has been extended to include 'Immuno ligands' - this refers to those ligands tagged in the database as being in GtoImmuPdb. It links to the updated ligand list page, focussed on the Immuno tab.
- The list has been re-ordered to put Antibodies second.
- All items link to updated ligand list page, keeping the GtoImmuPdb view (menu bar).

#### 2. Ligand List pages

##### i. URL

- <http://dev.guidetopharmacology.org/GRAC/LigandListForward?type=Immuno&database=all&imm=true>
  - linked to from ligand panel on GtoImmuPdb portal
  - linked to from Ligand list menu item, under Ligands
- ii. **Toggle**
- Button toggle, presented in GtoImmuPdb **gtip-blue** colour
  - Toggles between GtoImmuPdb view and standard GtoPdb view
  - Switches header banner and menu-bar
  - In GtoImmuPdb view, only ligands tagged in the database as being in GtoImmuPdb will be displayed in any of the tables.
- iii. **Immuno tab**
- Under the 'Immuno' tab, the table shows all ligands tagged as being in GtoImmuPdb.
- iv. **Immuno icons**
- A new icon has been designed and is displayed next to a ligand name (with other icons), if the ligand is tagged as being in GtoImmuPdb
3. **Ligand pages**

- Under the summary tab
  - Above the 'Comments' section a new section named 'Immunopharmacology' is displayed, with **gtip-blue** background if the ligand is tagged as being in GtoImmuPdb.
